In 2010 Umicore will grant a “**Umicore Scientific Award**” - amounting to 10.000 euro - for a **PhD-thesis** defended between October 1st, 2008 and September 30th, 2010 at a university in the European Economic Area + Switzerland.

In addition Umicore will also grant four 2.500 euro **Awards for MSc-theses** defended this academic year at a Belgian university.

Deadline for applications is October 1st, 2010.
